We widened 24 locations on our streets with new asphalt this week. We hope it will improve the turn radius as well as the aesthetics. Let's all try to keep it "On the Road".

Retreat House Update...

The following work has been completed:

- Rewire and new panel for old part of house
- Install new fans on front porch
- Install GFI in upstairs bath
- Install smoke detectors in old part of house to bring up to code
- Repoint all masonry on gable ends, front porch and side porch
- Replace all windows in sunroom
- Replace wood ceiling in sunroom
- Repair discovered termite damage in sunroom
- Replace interior trim in sunroom
- Repair and repaint ceilings, touchups in old part of house and sunroom
- Replace and reframe rear porch deck because of rotted wood.
- Repaint rear porch
- Add exterior lighting to the firepit area
- Repair and repaint areas around the exterior of the house

There is not yet a completion date for the project so stay tuned for more information!

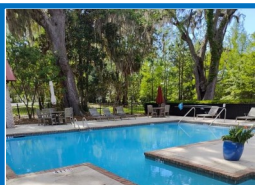
