Did you know...

that 50% of teachers who enter the profession are gone after five years? That's according to Beaufort County School Superintendent Dr. Frank Rodriguez. At a recent Beaufort County Senior Leadership Education Day class he gave quite a few interesting statistics and comments. (Quite a few Pinckney residents have completed this program or are currently involved in it! For a list of names, ask Cheryl Gaillard.) Dr. Rodriguez said that the two most common reasons for leaving are compensation and student behavior. He said that when he began teaching 30 years ago, his starting salary was \$30,000. When he arrived in 2019, the starting salary for teachers in Beaufort County was only \$37,000. Under his leadership, the district's FY2023 budget was unanimously approved, raising the starting teacher salary to \$50,066 and propelling the district from 53rd to 1st in teacher compensation in the state at that time. He also said that when issues with a child's behavior are raised with parents that too often it is turned back to the teacher on what she is doing wrong rather than focusing on improving the child's behavior.

Dr. Rodriguez was asked how the current discussion about dismantling the Department of Education would affect our schools. He said that too little is known but that it could affect certain grants funding with Title I schools and Special Ed programs. He iterated that almost all of BC schools funding is local with state funding filling up the rest of the budget.. Oddly, he noted that state funding is based on the wealth of the county, with the wealthiest getting the least funding. While Beaufort County is among the wealthiest in SC and getting the least amount of funding, 58.6% of Beaufort County students live below the poverty level.

Dr. Rodriguez was recently named the 2025 South Carolina Superintendent of the year, so I think we have a good leader at the helm of our schools going forward. ~CG
